



Congratulations on making it to the this stage of the selection process for the U-18 provincial team to compete at the 2010 Football Canada Cup in Wolfville, NS from July 10 – 17.

The following is a checklist of tasks that **ALL players** must complete prior to final stage of the camp:

- [] Complete the True Sport Clean 101 e-learning course.
- [] Attend and play in the exhibition game on Sunday, June 13.
- [] Bring a \$500 non-refundable* deposit payable to "Football BC" and hand it in during registration on June 13.
- [] Fill out the Player Registration Form and hand it in during registration on June 13 (Do NOT submit it to Football Canada despite what the form indicates).

*Non-refundable to players who make the final 40-man roster. Players who do not make the 40-man roster will have their \$500 cheques returned.

The following is a checklist of tasks that players **who make the final 40-team roster** must complete prior by Wednesday, June 30th:

- [] Check your e-mail on Monday, June 14 to find out if you make the final 40-man roster (contact communications@playfootball.bc.ca if you have not received notification).
- [] Pay the remainder of the final balance: \$1,600 - \$500 (deposit) = \$1,100 owing. This fee covers all expenses involved from July 7-18 including accommodations, meals, air travel, insurance, player attire, team uniform, medical needs, etc.).
- [] Apply for financial assistance (optional).
- [] Visit www.playfootball.bc.ca for up-to-date information on Team BC and the 2010 Football Canada Cup.

True Sport Clean 101

All players are required to complete the True Sport Clean 101 e-learning course online. To access the course, visit <http://education.cces.ca> and click 'Register'. Use activation code 5462EA032BEF518D to be assigned the course. You will then be asked to complete your user profile:

- Enter your first and last names and your role
- Choose a username and password
- When this is complete, the course will open to the home page.

The course can be completed in about 60 minutes. You can complete it in a single session or you may choose to exit at any time and return to where you left off when you next log in.

Each content module concludes with a three-question quiz. You must score at least 66% or you must repeat the module.

At the end of the course, a printable certificate will be available from the portal. Your progress report will also be available to Football Canada.

This course requires a high-speed internet connection and a browser, either Internet Explorer or Mozilla Firefox. Pop-ups must be enabled.
